Hoodies and any other t-shirts are not permitted. Thank you.




## **Traffic Lights in Baldwins Gate**

#### SICKNESS AND DIARRHOEA

A reminder of the school's policy with regard to sickness and diarrhoea. A child who has sickness or diarrhoea whilst at school is to be collected immediately and kept away until 48 hours following their last case of sickness and/or diarrhoea. If a child reports that they have had sickness and/or diarrhoea whilst at home, the school will contact the parent. If the parent confirms that this is the case, they will be asked to collect their child immediately.

This 48 hour rule is essential in order to protect other students or staff from contracting a bug. Unfortunately, this may mean that a student misses a school event.

Payment for school lunches, BUZZ and nursery wraparound must be paid for in advance on a Monday morning.

Services provided by Baldwins Gate Primary School are no different to those provided by any other business in that meals and other services must be paid for in advance and on demand. Most parents and carers understand that they cannot take their child to McDonald's and expect the provision of food or services without paying.

Please check your ParentPay account regularly and ensure your balance is not outstanding. Chasing outstanding money owed to the school causes considerable extra work for office staff and embarrassment for all concerned.

If you require any assistance with ParentPay, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Riley in the office. She will be only too happy to help.

#### **TAX FREE CHILDCARE PAYMENTS**

A number of families pay for Nursery Wraparound and BUZZ using the government's Tax-Free Childcare scheme. For every £8 you pay into the TFC online childcare account, the government will pay in £2.00 to use to pay your provider. It can sometimes take 10 days for payments to reach school. Would you please bear this in mind and process payments in advance to avoid your ParentPay account going into arrears. Thank you.

## Airfix Make n' Paint Sat, 16 Mar 2024 10:00 - 15:30

The Potteries Museum & Art Gallery Bethesda Street Stoke-on-Trent ST1 3DW

Build and paint your own model kit in the Spitfire Gallery! Perfect for first-time modellers, you'll learn how to assemble and



paint one of a range of vehicle models. Materials and models have been kindly provided by Airfix including Spitfires, iconic Sopwith Camel biplanes, Fokker DR1 triplanes, and WWI tanks.

Places are limited and booking is advised. Tickets are free but participants will be asked to fill out a short survey. This activity involves glue and paint, appropriate clothing is advised. These are authentic Airfix kits with small parts and detailed instructions. Children (16 and under) will need adult supervision and assistance. Depending on the age and competency of your child, one on one supervision may be required. The activity is not suitable for children under 5. Slots are booked for 60 minutes, with the first slot at 10am and the last 2:30pm. You may need to finish off your model at home. To claim your place, simply book a time slot. Each ticket reserves space for 1 person building 1 model. Multiple bookings for the same person are not permitted. Supervising adults who aren't building a kit themselves do not need to book a ticket. Please note that, due to availability of kits, we can't guarantee which model kit you will be given on the day.
