Save money on your childcare bills with Tax-Free

Childcare

If you're a working parent or carer, you can get up to \pounds 500 every three months (up to \pounds 2,000 a year per child) to help with the costs of childcare.

If your child has a disability, you can get up to £1,000 every three months (up to £4,000 a year per child). You can use it to pay for childcare including:

• childminders, nurseries and nannies



• playschemes, before and after school clubs, and holiday clubs

You can use the Tax-Free Childcare scheme to pay for BUZZ Breakfast and After School Club.
